Buildings and Grounds Maintenance

It shall be the policy of the Board that the school properties shall be maintained in good physical condition: safe, clean, sanitary, as comfortable and convenient as the facilities will permit or the use requires.

The superintendent shall be responsible for: (a) the constant review of school building needs and, when a building program has been approved by the Board, for the supervision of new construction; and (b) the maintenance of school property and for operation of school plans.

Within each individual school, during the school year the principal shall be responsible for the care and upkeep of the building and for the supervision of the school custodial services.
