Special Use of School Buses

School buses may be used for educational activities other than home-to-school transportation to include spectator trips, field trips and travel to athletic events and school-sponsored activities by official school groups. Administrative regulations will be established for these special uses.

Private, Parochial and Public Charter Schools

All resident students attending any private, parochial or public charter school within the district under compulsory school attendance laws shall be entitled equally to the same rights, benefits and privileges as to transportation providing that:

1. The student is on a route established by the Board to serve public school students; and
2. The school is within three miles of a designated route or terminus of a route and the school is within the district boundaries.

Students who attend public charter schools and who reside outside of the school district may use existing bus routes and transportation services of the district provided the public charter school is located in the district.

In accordance with law, the district may not be required to add or extend existing bus routes or other transportation services.
