

Use of Feature Films/Videos in the School**

For feature films/videos with a PG or PG-13 rating, prior administrative notification will be required before a student views the film. For PG or PG-13 rated feature films/videos, parental notification will be required prior to the student viewing the film.

Instructors are required to preview all film media before showing to students.

A parent may have the opportunity to preview a film when practicably possible and that parent must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated PG or PG-13.

Under special circumstances, an R rated film may be shown. Teachers must request prior administrator approval for the showing of such films. Additionally, instructors are required to send a specific permission note to parents (with appropriate film information). Written parental permission is required in order for the student to view the film. An alternative assignment (with no grade penalty) must be provided for any student denied permission to see an R rated film.

Edited or unrated films/videos will be shown at the discretion of the building administrator.
